We do have some supplies at school; however, we know some students prefer to use their own. When making your purchase, you may want to consider that your supplies are kept in your locker at night, and carried from class to class during the school day. Please be sure to label the supplies you bring to school. The following items are useful 'tools' for a successful 5th grader:

- *Three 1" binders* (a different color for each subject - Math, Language Arts and Social Studies)
- *1 composition book* (math)
- *2 - 1-subject notebooks* (reading/writing)
- *2 - set of 5 dividers with tabs* (for Language Arts and Math Binder)
- *Stretchable Jumbo book cover*
- *Pencils-* If using mechanical pencils be sure you have enough lead, in addition to some regular pencils for back ups.
- *Pencil Container-* A zipper bag is best (boxes tend to open up when dropped on the floor).
- *Colored Pencils*
- *Sticky Notes*
- *Dry Erase Markers*
- *Glue Sticks*
- *Erasers*
- *Student scissors*
- *Books or educational magazines* for daily independent reading.
- *Water Bottle-* You may drink water in class if it is in a water bottle.
- *Snack-* Students may bring in a snack, as long as it is not candy and does not contain nuts. Please try to bring a nutritious snack along with a napkin.
- *Kleenex* (to donate to our classroom)
- *Clorox Wipes & Sanitizer* (to donate to our classroom)
