Suggested Supply List Droelle/May

- **5 POCKET FOLDERS (with holes if you plan to use a binder) –**
 - 5 SOLID COLOR folders...the cheap 25 cent variety will work, but break down quickly-your money is better spent on THE PLASTIC variety if you can. These last all year.
 - **YELLOW, RED, GREEN, BLUE, PURPLE or another color of your choice.**
 - We are color coding folders to subjects.
 - **DO NOT LABEL FOLDERS!! WE WILL DO IT AT SCHOOL TOGETHER.** ☺
 - You may want to buy folders with holes if you plan to put them in a 3 ring binder to help you carry them around school.

Many students find it is helpful to have something to put their folders, notebooks, and planner in to carry them from class to class. Trapper Keepers (or similar) tend to be **VERY heavy** and encourage students to “stuff and go.”

3 ring binders (1.5” – 2”) tend to be a better alternative. Many students just choose to carry their belongings. You will know what works best for your child.

- **2 COMPOSITION NOTEBOOKS** – These are designed for writers. They usually have a black and white cover. Target usually has them in their dollar bins around the start of school and the Dollar Store usually carries them as well. (We will use these for Reader’s and Writer’s Workshop.)
- **ONE 2” 3 RING BINDER for Reading/Writing** – We will use this to organize our reading and writing workshop resources. This will be kept in the classroom.
- **PENCIL BAG** – Pencil boxes tend to fall on the floor and break open or break. They are also difficult when switching classes.
- **PENCILS** – if you choose mechanical pencils make sure you have some regular pencils as backups AND YOUR OWN LEAD ☺
- **COLORED PENCILS or CRAYONS**– a pack of 24 or more work best.
NOTE: Markers will not be permitted for most coloring projects.
- **GLUE STICKS** – the large ones work best or multiple small ones
- **CHECKING PENS** – blue and red are best, milky pens not acceptable for checking
- **YELLOW HIGHLIGHTER**
- **SCISSORS**
- **DRY ERASE MARKERS** – We will be using these in math to practice our math problems.
