### **Suggested Supply List 2020-2021**

We do have some supplies at school; however, we know some students prefer to use their own. When making your purchase, you may want to consider that your supplies are carried from class to class during the school day. Please be sure to label the supplies you bring to school. The following items are useful 'tools' for a successful 5<sup>th</sup> grader:

- **Three 1" binders** (a different color for each subject - Math, Language Arts and Social Studies/Science)
  - OR- a Trapper Keeper style binder containing a separate folder for each of the 4 subjects
- **One 3-subject spiral notebook** (reading & writing)
- **1 set of 5 dividers with tabs**
- **Pencils**- If using mechanical pencils be sure you have enough lead, in addition to some regular pencils for back ups.
- **Pencil Container**- A zipper bag is best (boxes tend to open when dropped on the floor).
- **Colored Pencils**
- **Sticky Notes**
- **Dry Erase Markers**
- **Glue Sticks**
- **Erasers**
- **Student scissors**
- **Books or educational magazines** for daily independent reading.
- **Water Bottle**- spill/leak proof is recommended
- **Snack**- Students may bring in a snack if it is not candy and does not contain nuts. Please try to bring a nutritious snack along with a napkin.
- **Kleenex** (classroom donation)
- **Sanitizer** (classroom donation)

**\*Basic yellow pencils sharpen best at school (Ticonderoga brand for example)**
